- Cross Rail Hunters (no oxers, simple changes of lead are acceptable)
  - 2' Hunter (no oxers, simple changes of lead are acceptable)
- 2'3" Hunter (oxers permitted with breakaway cups, simple changes of lead are acceptable)
- 2'6 / 3' Hunter (oxers with breakaway cups, combinations permitted with adjusted distances)
  - Conformation Mares In Hand
  - Conformation Geldings In Hand

## JUMPERS

- Cross Rail Jumpers (no oxers, no combinations)
  - .70m Jumpers (no oxers, no combinations)
- .80m Jumpers (oxers permitted w/breakaway cups, combinations permitted with adj. distances)
- .90m/1.0m Jumpers (oxers permitted w/breakaway cups, combinations permitted with adj. distances)

## EQUITATION

- Junior/Amateur Equitation 18" Cross Rails (no oxers, no combinations, simple changes are acceptable)
- Junior/Amateur Equitation 2'/2'3" Equitation (no oxers, no combinations, simple changes are acceptable)
  - Junior/Amateur Equitation 2'6" Equitation (oxers permitted w/breakaway cups, combinations permitted with adj. distances)

# LUDWIG'S CORNER THOROUGHBRED TAKEOVER

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ENTRIES: Pre-Entries are encouraged by Friday, June 26 at 9 p.m. ONLINE: [www.ringradar.com](http://www.ringradar.com) Entry fee \$30 per class, Entry fee for Jumper Classic and Hunter Derby \$50/per class. The \$20 office fee is non-refundable and applies to all entries (Lead Line exempt). A \$10 Grounds/EMT fee applies to all entries.
2. SHOW OFFICE: will be open at 7AM the morning of the show. Entry forms must be accompanied in the show office with a current negative Coggins for each horse. Entries can be paid by cash or check made payable to "LCHSA", but all entries MUST have a credit card on file for incidentals or classes that may be applied to your account after you check out. Entries paid by credit card must have a completed credit card authorization form on file. Checks must have a daytime phone number on them. All returned methods of payment will be subject to a \$100 processing fee. Any fees associated with collecting will be the responsibility of the rider and/or owner. Day of Show Phone (302)373-5508
3. EXHIBITOR PARKING: NO passenger cars are allowed in trailer parking. Please ensure all your tack and supplies are with the trailer before you leave for the show. Please park passenger cars in front lots towards Horse Show Grounds Entrance.
4. NUMBERS: No numbers will be given out without full payment of entry fees, as well as all required signatures, and all other information clearly marked on the entry blank. A parent/guardian must sign the entry for their minor child. Trainers cannot sign for juniors. Incomplete or illegible entries will incur a post entry fee (i.e. please do not use "same" when completing entry). All horses/ponies must wear a number when mounted.
5. HOW MANY/RESULTS: [www.ringradar.com](http://www.ringradar.com)
6. SCRATCH/ADDS: Horses not properly scratched will forfeit their entry fee for that class.
7. REFUNDS: If a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to being shown in any class, the entry fee will be refunded by mail upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate. Refunds will be mailed 30 days after the show. The non-refundable \$20 office fee per horse or equitation rider will be deducted from all refunded entries.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

8. **SCHOOLING:** Schooling will begin at 7:15AM day of the show in Ring 3 and the Schooling Ring. Participants must complete an entry blank and credit card authorization form with the show office before entering the ring. Office fee applies. Jumpers do one course walk before the division. Schooling will be permitted only in the areas provided by the committee.
9. **SHADE TENTS/CANOPIES:** No outside tents/canopies are to be erected around the competition rings, but are allowed by the trailers. A limited number of 10'x10' spaces above Rings 1 & 2 will be available for exhibitor families/barns to reserve. Pitch your own canopy for \$25 for the day. Pay for tent reservations via [PayPal@LudwigsShow](mailto:PayPal@LudwigsShow) and include LAST NAME and preferred Ring to reserve your space. Specific spaces will not be reserved, First come, first served. Canopies must be secured.
10. **PHOTOGRAPHY:** Alyssa Murphree Media is the official show photographer. [alyssamurphreemedia.com](http://alyssamurphreemedia.com) Exhibitors are encouraged to book with our recommended photographer in advance, if they wish to have their classes professionally shot.
11. **E-BIKES/E-SCOOTERS/Golf Carts:** Charging e-bikes, e-scooters and golf carts on the show grounds is not permitted. No recreational vehicles over 49cc will be allowed on the show grounds.
12. **The Rosato Oval:** 150'x 280' fiber GGT Footing™/sand footing. Ring 2: 120'x 250' sand/stone dust. Ring 3: 120'x220' sand/stone dust. Schooling Ring: 90'x170' sand/ stone dust. Warm Up Ring 3: 120'x60'. Lunging/Flatting Area: 100'x100' grass (if footing permits).
13. All classes are open to Juniors, Amateurs and Professionals. Prize money will be applied to the exhibitor's account. Prize Money Checks will be mailed within 1 week of show and must be cashed within 30 days or they will not be honored. No refunds on prize money classes once the order of go has been established or division has started.
14. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. Any additional specifications will be noted. No martingales in under saddle classes.
15. Hunter courses may include verticals, brush, coops, oxers, post and rail, in and out, walls, log, gates; and will be posted at the in-gate at least one hour prior to each class.
16. Jumper courses may include verticals, oxers, panels, gates, spreads, and combinations. No liverpools.
17. Jumpers – all ties involving first place shall be jumped off. All ties for placings other than first will be broken by first round time. The time allowed is based on 350 meter/ minute for all jumper classes. No martingale restrictions when used in the conventional manner. See JP111.

# LUDWIG'S CORNER THOROUGHBRED TAKEOVER RULES AND REGULATIONS

18. Champion & Reserve Champion – based on points won in a section/division. 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5 points. A minimum of three classes must be held in the section/division (exemption from this is jumper divisions with only two assigned classes). Grand Champions are calculated on total ribbons earned in qualifying classes/divisions. All classes in equitation and hunter divisions will receive equal points. All winner awards, ribbons and prizes are courtesy of the Ludwig's Corner Horse Show Association unless otherwise noted. 8 ribbons per class unless otherwise noted.
19. Courses & fences: Show management reserves the right to change the obstacles or vary the courses at their discretion, including use of dotted - mandatory line/courtesy circle. Fence heights are approximate.
20. Jump order: Hunters and Jumpers will be determined at the gate.
21. Conflicts will be handled at the gate. Under saddle classes are not considered a trainer conflict and will not be held. Please be ready for your class.
22. Show management reserves the right to cancel any class when in its judgment the entries are inadequate and to combine or divide any class or classes should the best interest of the show require it. Any division with 20 or more entries will be split.
23. If necessary to meet time schedule requirements, show management reserves the to limit the number of entries accepted in each division or class. First come, first served basis. Also reserved is the right to move the location of classes, and adjust the time schedule if in the opinion of management circumstances dictate such changes.
24. Should a question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final. LCHS conforms to the current USEF rulebook.
25. Exhibitors are notified that any discourtesy or disobedience to show officials, show staff, employees, committee members or show volunteers on the part of an owner, trainer, rider, groom, agent or family member shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees.
26. Exhibitors must be in proper riding attire for their class and wear ASTM/SEI approved protective headgear. No cell phone use/ear bud use while mounted in show or schooling rings, or while lunging.
27. DOGS must be on a leash.

# LUDWIG'S CORNER THOROUGHBRED TAKEOVER RULES AND REGULATIONS

28. The Ludwig's Corner Horse Show/Ludwig's Corner Horse Show Association/ Foundation (LCHSA) will not be responsible for any loss, damage or illness that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor/rider/driver/handler/ coach and trainer, and his/her agent(s), guardian, or parent shall indemnify and hold the Ludwig's Corner Horse Show Association/Foundation; its directors, members, employees, volunteers ("released parties") harmless for any illness, loss, accident or injury which may occur to any owner, exhibitor, groom, attendant, spectator, animal or equipment at the show.
29. In the case of an incomplete entry blank by a rider, trainer, coach and/or parent, the first entrance into the ring as an exhibitor shall be construed as their acceptance of the rules & regulations of the competition and of LCHSA and shall make them subject to those rules & regulations.
30. LCHSA may use or assign photographs, videos, audios or other likeness of exhibitors and horses taken during the course of the competition for the ongoing promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition in 2025 or the future. All rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation are expressly and irrevocably waived.
31. Participants utilizing an online entry system for this competition do so with the agreement that they have read the official prize list and entry blank and agree to follow all class specifications, rules, requirements, regulations and conditions in the official prize list and on the entry blank.
